

The Department of English, French and German at the University of Vigo invites proposals for participation in the seminar “**Cultural Studies Reloaded: Analysing Popular Culture Manifestations in English**”, to be held in Vigo on 22 March 2023. Directed at undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral students, this event seeks to bring researchers together and create a forum for reflection, debate and exchange of ideas regarding the study of popular culture in English.

We invite submissions broadly approaching the field of cultural studies in English. Therefore, papers may explore a wide range of cultural products and genres (e.g. literature, film and television, print media, music, advertising, etc.), or focus on theoretical and methodological issues.

Although other topics may be considered, we are particularly keen to receive proposals on:

- Aspects of cultural production, consumption, inculcation, regulation and distribution
- Analysis of cultural forms and activities
- Identity construction and identification processes
- Hybridisation, borderlands and subcultures
- Popular culture and its relations with ‘high’ and mass culture
- The intercultural and the translation of cultures

Those who wish to participate in the seminar may send their **proposals for 15-minute papers to ataboada@uvigo.gal and inmaculada.perez@uvigo.gal before 22 February 2023**.^{*} The abstracts must include the title of the paper, the speaker’s name, institution and email address. They should be no longer than 250 words, including bibliography.
