# 9th International Conference on Discourse Markers in Romance Languages (DISROM 9)

University of Oviedo, Spain | June 10–12, 2026

Following the tradition of previous editions held in Madrid (2010), Buenos Aires (2011), Campinas (2012), Heidelberg (2015), Louvain-la-Neuve (2017), Bergamo (2019), Craiova (2022), and Lisbon (2024), the University of Oviedo is pleased to host the 9<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Discourse Markers in Romance Languages (DISROM 9), which will take place from June 10 to 12, 2026. This edition aims to revisit the conference's original spirit by placing a special emphasis on contrastive analyses of discourse markers across Romance languages.

### Conference Themes

- Synchronic and diachronic studies of discourse markers in Romance languages.
- Contrastive analyses involving two or more Romance languages, or different varieties of a single Romance language.
- Discourse markers in second language acquisition contexts.
- Issues related to the translation and interpretation of discourse markers.

### Submission Guidelines

Proposals for oral presentations (20 minutes + 10 minutes for discussion) must be submitted via the [EasyChair platform](#) and include a brief biographical note.

Abstracts (maximum 300 words) should clearly present:

- Theoretical framework
- Objectives
- Methodology
- Expected or obtained results
- Selected references (minimum 5, maximum 8)

All submissions will undergo a double-blind peer review by members of the Scientific Committee.

### Conference Languages

Proposals may be submitted and presented in any Romance language.
